

LOUP VALLEY 4-H HORSE CONFERENCE CLUB

APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: April 20, 2018

Eligibility: Applicant must have participated in five (5) Loup Valley 4-H Conference Horse Shows in his/her last two years (2016 & 2017). If he/she does not receive a scholarship as a Senior in high school they may apply during their Freshman year of college, as long as they have NOT turned 19 on or before January 1 of the current year. The Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference Scholarship Show will count toward the total show count for the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Scholarship. Counties with eligible scholarship recipients include the ten conference counties which are Garfield, Loup, Wheeler, Nance, Merrick, Boone, Howard, Sherman, Valley & Greeley Counties. The remainder of the counties statewide are considered guest counties. Proof of attendance at the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference Scholarship Shows must be documented by show committee and given to Ann Teply prior to participant consideration for the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Scholarship.

A local committee will be formed to determine eligibility of the applicants before scholarship funds are given out.

Scholarship will be awarded upon completion of one semester of post high school education with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average. Present proof of qualification with 12 months after selection to Ann Teply, 47824 794th Rd, Loup City, NE 68853
