# LOUP VALLEY 4-H HORSE CONFERENCE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION <br> Deadline: April 1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ 

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must have participated in five (5) Loup Valley 4-H Conference Horse Shows in his/her last two years of $4-$ Heligibility. If he/she does not receive a scholarship as a Senior in high school they may apply during their Freshman year of college as long as they have NOT turned 19 on or before January 1 of the current year. The Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference Scholarship Show will count toward the total show count for the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Scholarship.
Counties with eligible scholarship recipients include the ten conference counties which are Boone, Garfield, Greeley, Howard, Loup, Wheeler, Merrick Nance, Sherman \& Valley Counties. The remainder of the counties statewide are considered guest counties. Proof of attendance at the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference Shows must be documented by show committee prior to participant being considered for the Loup Valley 4-H Horse Scholarship.

A local committee will be formed to determine eligibility of the applicants. Mail applications to Ann Teply, $47824794^{\text {th }}$ Road, Loup City, NE 68853. Applications must be received on or before April $1^{\text {st }}$.

Scholarship winners will be announced on or around May $1^{\text {stt }}$.
Scholarship funds will be awarded upon completion of one semester of post high school education with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average. Present proof of grade qualification within12 months after selection to any Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference board member, or bring to a Loup Valley 4-H Horse Conference meeting.
